**BREEDING DAYS** – Beginning February 13th, 2012 and ending July 21, 2012, Muscle hill will be collected Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. Semen will be available for pick-up at the farm by 12:00pm.

**All semen requests must be made by 10:00am (Eastern Time) the day BEFORE collection.** Confirmation must be made the breeding day by 10:00am. Please call us Saturday and/or Sunday for semen needed Monday.

**Mares will be covered no more than 1 times per heat cycle.** If you require semen a 2nd time, please call Southwind Farms. In the event we have extra semen, we will honor your request; however, there will be an extra charge for 3 or more covers.

Call-in times will be **STRICTLY** enforced and are non-negotiable.

**SEMEN SHIPPING** – Same day semen shipment is available VIA airport, however, you are fully responsible for all expenses and for making the arrangements with a courier and airlines. No overnight shipments. As always Trailer breeds and local pickups are also accepted. Local pickup time is 12:00pm, trailer breeds should be at the farm by 1:00pm.

**\*\*\*Canadian Shipments**—There will be a \$500 processing fee for any semen being shipped to Canada. The new shipping rules require a USDA health certificate and permit for shipping semen to Canada. Acquiring these permits are very costly and time consuming. Our collections are on a very time sensitive schedule as it is. This fee does not include shipping fees or regular semen processing fees. Please see your Breeding agreement for further information.

**\*\*Southwind Farms is not taking any boarders at this time\*\*** There are several very reliable farms in the area that have had great success with getting mares in foal in the past. We can provide you with the names and numbers of the farms. Mare management is very important and boarding your mare at a farm with experienced and capable personnel is highly recommended.

**MANAGING FARMS & PERSONNEL** – We highly recommend controlled estrous cycles and induction of ovulation when possible with HCG or Deslorine. Having an experienced Veterinarian or personal following your mare's cycles via Palpation or Ultrasound is a very important. These are small mare management recommendations that can be the difference between a barren mare and an in foal mare.

**NOTE: Please be sure that all required documents are on file and signed with Southwind Farms, prior to requesting semen.** If your mares are being boarded at a farm other than your own, please be sure that they are notified of the above schedule.
